

Profile of Dr. Raju Bolla

Dr. Raju Bolla is a distinguished academic leader, ODL administrator, and scholar with more than two decades of experience spanning higher education, research, and open and distance learning systems. Born in Suripalli village into a farming family, he embodies a deep commitment to rural development, educational empowerment, and inclusive learning, values that continue to define his professional journey.

Academic Background and Early Career

Dr. Raju Bolla completed his schooling in Suripalli and Nekkonda, followed by Intermediate studies at Government Junior College, Hanumakonda. He earned his B.Sc., M.Sc., and Ph.D. in Botany from the Kakatiya University. His doctoral research on cyanobacteria contributes to sustainable agriculture and environmental bio-sciences. He is also trained in education and distance learning through a B.Ed. and PGDDE.

He served for a decade as Lecturer in Botany (2001–2011), where he taught undergraduate programmes, supervised evaluations, and participated in examination and academic planning systems. His active involvement in NSS since his school days strengthened his inclination towards community-centric education.

Leadership Career in IGNOU

Selected as Assistant Regional Director in 2011, Dr. Raju Bolla served at RC Trivandrum before being posted to IGNOU Regional Centre, Hyderabad in the year 2013. Rising through positions of increasing responsibility, he became Deputy Director in the year 2023 and Regional Director in November 2025. His leadership has significantly shaped the growth, quality assurance, and public engagement of IGNOU in Telangana.
