## Indira Gandhi National Open University Regional Centre : Hyderabad

## 1. Unnat Bharat Abhiyan

**Village Adoption Scheme**: Under Unnar Bharat Abhiyan programme RC, Hyderabad had adopted five Villages for the empowerement of Rural Youth.

- a. Weavers Community: Village clusters identified with weavers' community like Bhoodan Pochampally and Jangaon were adopted. To empower the Weavers Community especially the youth an interactive sessions were arranged by conducting Sibirs. These Sibirs were attended by the Collectors and Peoples Representatives such as; Hon'ble Member of Legislative Assembly and Member of Parliament.
- b. High Stake Villages: Regional centre also adopted the villages which were identified as model villages at National Level. The village Erravalli is adopted by the Chief Minister of Telangana State. The villagers have come forward with a request for the skill based programmes offered by IGNOU. Similarly the Regional Centre adopted Gangadevipalle, a model village. A detailed survey on educational profile of the village was conducted. The village head organized an interactive session with the Academic of Regional Centre. The educated youth, women and adults were encouraged to undergo the sill development programmes offered by the IGNOU.
- c. Dairy Village: The Village, Kesavaram is a known for milk production. The educated natives of the village were mobilized for a orientation programme to empower them to develop their skills. The orientation programme was followed by enrollment of the villagers in IGNOU's familiar skill based programme Diploma in Dairy Technology.

## 2. Swach Bharat Abhiyan
